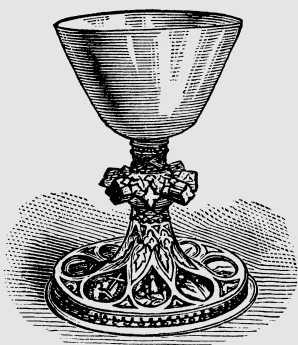

MASS

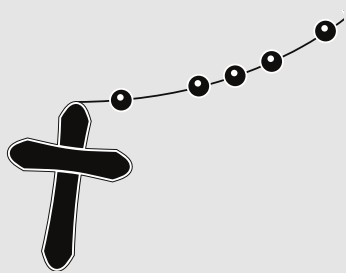
Attend Mass, in person or watch virtually, on March 19, the Solemnity of St Joseph, and May 1, the Feast of St Joseph the Worker

CONSECRATION

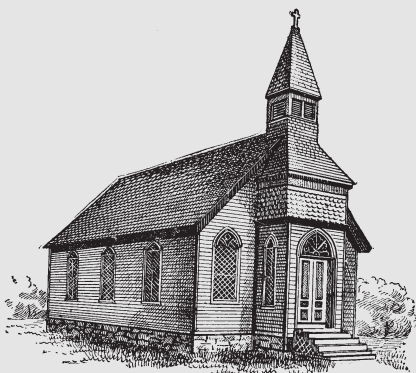
Take part in the Consecration of St Joseph, which will occur on May 1, or choose one of the [other appropriate days](#) in the year for this Consecration
